

41st Annual MAC-A-THON

5K & 10K Race

March 30, 2024 7:00 AM, SATURDAY

(The day before Easter)

The Mac-A-Thon is Hawai'i Island's oldest annual 5 & 10 km race, and also one of the oldest races in Hawai'i. It was started in 1981 as a benefit for Keoua Canoe Club, which originated in the 1930s as Honaunau Canoe Club. The race course is a round trip on the old government road that extends from sacred Honaunau Bay to Napo'opo'o. You won't want to miss our famous Mac-Nut Pancake Breakfast (included with entry fee), the awards ceremony, entertainment, and silent auction. Bring the whole family!

DIRECTIONS TO START: Take Hwy 11 to Hwy 160 junction (Honaunau Post Office), turn makai on Hwy 160 and continue approximately 3 miles to the start/finish line near the Pu'uhonua O Honaunau Park entrance. **Race registration will be at the Keoua halau**, on the north side of the beach road. Early entry race t-shirt and number pickup on Friday, April 7th, 4-6 pm.
